

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

As restrictions on Construction have been lifted by the Province of Ontario, City led infrastructure will continue to proceed. During construction, the Contractor is responsible for Health and Safety on site under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act and is expected to implement COVID-19 mitigation practices. **Physical Distancing:** There are times when contractors need to communicate with property owners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, exterior pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing.

Where possible, a phone number for a contact person on-site will be provided on notices, to answer questions about work near your property. At other times, the contractor may knock on your door, but will then step away the required distance to discuss the work that is taking place and what can be expected that day. Please practice physical distancing with workers so everyone can remain safe. If you have questions, call the contact provided on this notice.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. Metro Asphalt will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



**Work Hours**: Work will take place from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



**Road and Sidewalk Access:** In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road restrictions within the construction work area. The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access.



**Traffic Management**: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.



**Parking:**You may park outside of the construction work zone. Please arrange to park elsewhere on streets that allow on-street parking and be aware of parking restrictions on the street.





	Please note: Parking tickets cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in no parking zones), or if they are submitted no later than <b>three</b> days after receipt.
Ī.	Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.
Ė	Residents that require accommodation must contact Domenic to arrange for access during the construction period.
